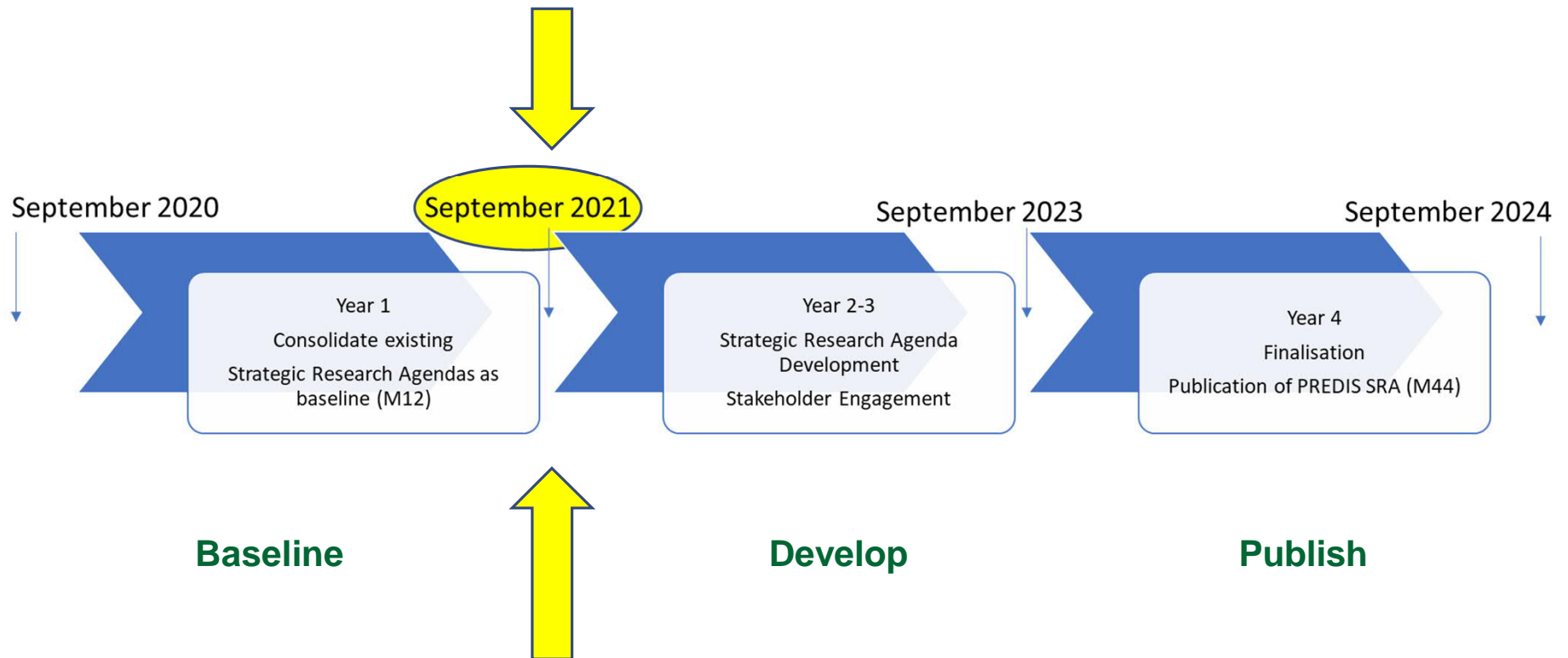

# SRA Development Schedule

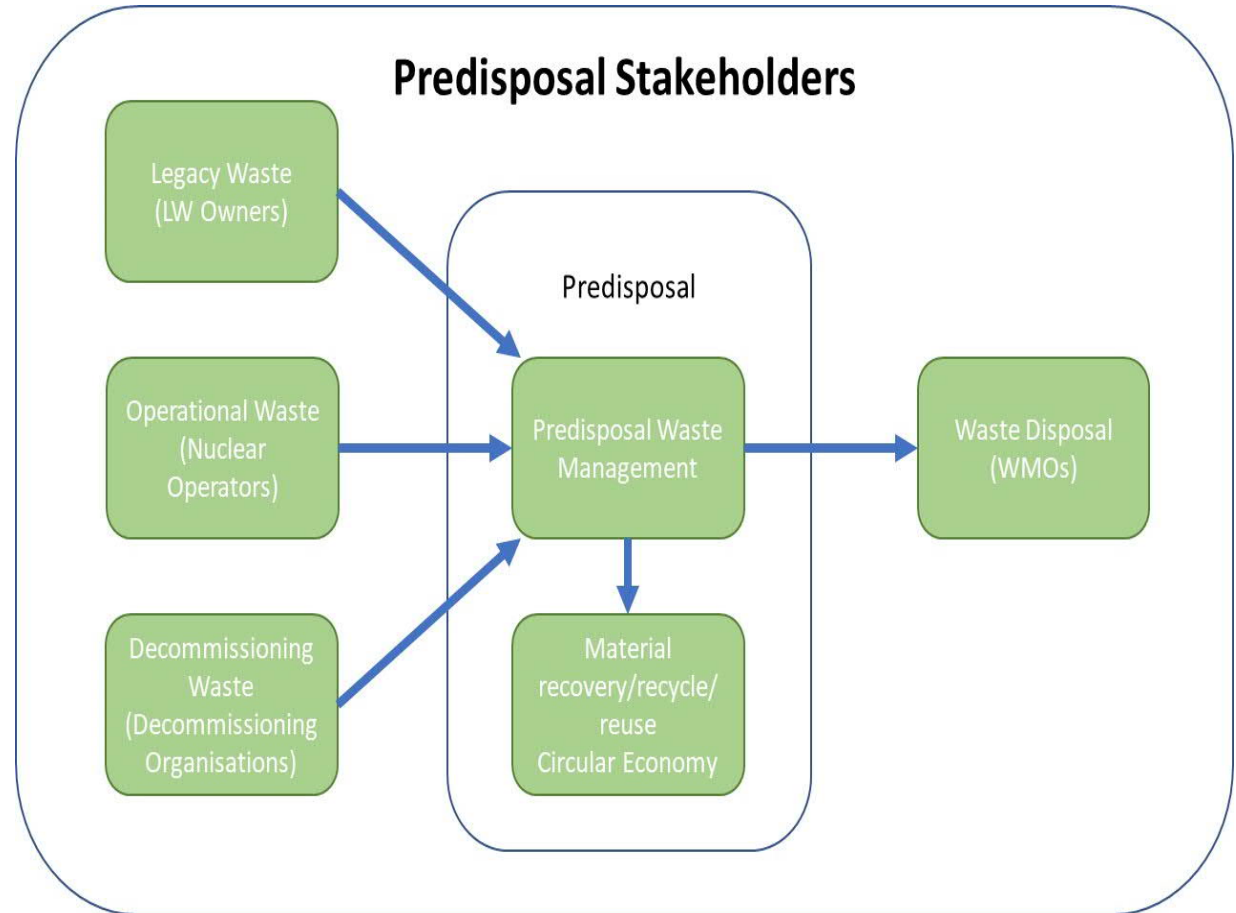


# Years 2 &3 SRA Development

PREDIS aims to produce an informative long term, future focussed SRA based on a holistic lifecycle philosophy, of both relevance and use to the Commission and different stakeholders.

The PREDIS SRA should complement the updated EURAD SRA and, ideally, contains the same structure and types of information.

Engagement with the relevant stakeholder communities is key to achieving this aim and build a comprehensive Predisposal SRA.

- Mixed methods will be used to facilitate this engagement, including for example stakeholder workshops, surveys, facilitated discussions, engagement with other relevant projects (e.g. SHARE, EURAD) and relevant stakeholder organisations (e.g. SNETP, IAEA, NEA etc.).
  - Inclusion of the output from the PREDIS Gap Analysis Task 2.6 Deliverable D2.2 and the relevant predisposal elements of the SHARE SRA to be published in PREDIS Year 2.
